

The California Association For Property & Evidence is proud to announce the official launch of the 2016 Pink Patch Project, a collaborative cancer awareness fundraiser in partnership with the Los Angeles County Police Chief's Association and many other L.A. County Police Agencies. The goal of this project is to raise funds to further the research, treatment, and care of those who are and have battled cancer. Equally important during this time is to educate the public as much as we can about the early detection and prevention.
